I, the undersigned, certify that the consignment described above,

- meets applicable requirements of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, including that it comes from an establishment subject to periodic inspection by FDA that has been shown by such inspections to be in substantial compliance with the relevant US public health standards requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations.

The manufacturer's legally binding declaration to FDA specific to this consignment confirms, subject to criminal penalties for falsification that the gelatin:

- (a) has been derived from animals which have been slaughtered in a slaughterhouse and whose carcasses have been found fit for human consumption following ante and post mortem inspection, and, for ruminants, which have not been slaughtered after stunning by means of gas injected into the cranial cavity or killed by the same method or slaughtered by laceration after stunning of central nervous tissue by means of an elongated rod-shaped instrument introduced into the cranial cavity;
- (b) does not contain and is not derived from prohibited cattle materials as defined in 21 CFR Parts 189.5 and 700.27;
- (c) has been obtained by the partial hydrolysis of collagen derived from hides, connective tissue, and/or bones of cattle, swine, maybe either Type A (derived from an acid-treated precursor) or Type B (derived from an alkali treated precursor) that has gone through processing steps that include filtration and sterilization or an equivalent process in terms of infectivity reduction.
