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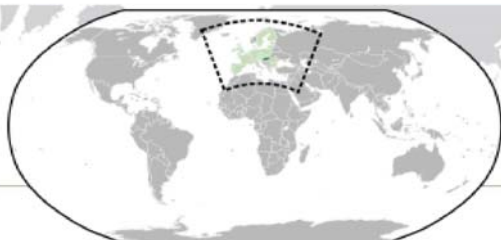

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Trade in the European Union

- Intra Union trade (trade between MSs)
 - Import (from third countries outside EU)
 - Export (to third countries)
 - Transit (from a 3rd country to a 3rd country through EU)
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Forms of trade from the European Union point of view



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Export checks

- The dispatched consignment has to be accompanied by a health certificate with the certified requirements of the third country of destination;
- The export certificates must contain only such requirements which can be certified by the sender competent authority;



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Export of live animals and products of animal origin to Third Countries

- After the consultation of the central competent authorities.
- When the negotiation is done by the European Commission, export certificates are stored within TRACES system
- When the negotiations are done bilaterally between Hungary and the concerned third country the export health certificates are stored and uploaded in the national system (OÁIR database – national animal health information system)
- In Hungary, official veterinarians only allowed to certify such export health certificates, which can be found on the central 'OÁIR' database.

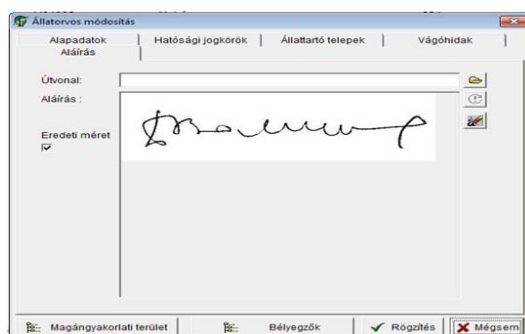


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Export of live animals and products of animal origin to Third Countries

Every official veterinarian has a unique numbered official stamp.

The print of the official stamp and the signatures of the official veterinarians are also stored in the 'OÁIR' system.



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Export of live animals and products of animal origin to Third Countries

Third Countries may require additional security measures during the certification for export such as:

- Printing onto **papers with watermark**
- Use of unique numbered **hologram stickers**



The watermark papers and hologram stickers are provided by National Food Chain Safety Office of Hungary, stored in a safe, beside strict registration.



Export of live animals and products of animal origin to Third Countries

- Hungary regularly host audit delegations from Third Countries
 - Export approved establishment list
 - Modification of export approved establishment list is based on common procedure through agreed communication channels.
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WHAT IS TRACES?

- **T**rade **C**ontrol and **E**xpert **S**ystem
 - **TRACES** is the European Commission's multilingual online management tool for all sanitary requirements on **intra-EU trade and importation of animals, semen and embryo, food, feed and plants**.
 - Its main objective is to digitise the entire certification process and linked procedures, and is in line with the declaration of the Digital Agenda for Europe.

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History of TRACES

- **Sanitary crisis**
 - Classical Swine Fever 1997
 - **Reports**
 - Court of Auditors (Special Report 1/2000)

History of TRACES

Since then, the main steps taken:

- Started on 1st April 2004 (pilot phase)
 - A few countries joined TRACES at this phase.
 - Since 1/01/2005 mandatory for all BIPs and LVUs (animals and products of animal origin)
 - Since 2011, it can be used for products of non animal origin
 - Since 2013, it can be used for live plants

Legal basis of TRACES

- Commission Decision 2003/24/EC: development of an integrated computerised veterinary system
 - Commission Decision 2003/623/EC: development of an integrated computerised veterinary system known as TRACES
 - Commission Decision 2004/292/EC: introduction of the TRACES system and amendment of Decision 92/486/EEC
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TRACES now

- About 30 000 users from more than 80 countries worldwide are interconnected through TRACES, centralising all data, simplifying and accelerating the trading process.
 - TRACES facilitates the exchange of information between all involved trading parties and control authorities and speeds up the administrative procedures.
 - The possibility to trace back and forth all the movements of animals, semen and embryo, food, feed and plants contributes to the reduction of the impact of disease outbreaks and brings a quick response to any sanitary alert, for the better protection of consumers, livestock and plants.

TRACES now

- The network promotes a **better cooperation** between the competent authorities but also between the traders themselves and their competent authorities. When a decision is taken, the involved parties gain access to the official documents and receive **alert notifications** in case of a problem with the consignment. TRACES allows the quick detection of fake certificates and therefore contributes to the enhancement of trust vis-à-vis its partners.
 - TRACES is available in **35 languages** preventing errors in regards to data introduction. **24 hours** a day, **7 days** a week, **free** of charge.
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TRACES users, level of access

- EU and MS TRACES Administrators
- Central Competent Authority
- Border Inspection Posts (veterinary and phytosanitary)
- Local Veterinary Unit
- Customs
- Economic operators
- Private Veterinarian

The level of access depends on the status of the user to ensure safety of data.



Certificates under TRACES

- **Intratrade Animal Health Certificate (INTRA)**
Commission Regulation (EC) No 599/2004 as regards the adoption of a harmonised model certificate and inspection report linked to intra-Community trade in animals and products of animal origin.
- **Commercial Document (DOCOM)**
Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 as regards animal byproducts and derived products not intended for human consumption.
- **Export Health certificate (EXPORT)**
As regards harmonised certificates at EU level.



Certificates under TRACES

- **Common Entry Document (CED)**
Commission Regulation (EC) No 669/2009 as regards the increased level of official controls on imports of certain feed and food of non-animal origin.
- **Common Veterinary Entry Document: Animals (CVEDA)**
Commission Regulation (EC) No 282/2004 introducing a document for the declaration of, and veterinary checks on, animals from third countries entering the Community
- **Common Veterinary Entry document: Products (CVEDP)**
Commission Regulation (EC) No 136/2004 laying down procedures for veterinary checks at Community border inspection posts on products imported from third countries



Certificates under TRACES

- **Declaration document (DECLAR)**

Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 as regards certain samples and items exempt from veterinary checks at the border.

- **Common Health Entry Document for Plants and Plant protection (CHED-PP)**

Council Directive 2000/29/EC on protective measures against the introduction into the Community of organisms harmful to plants or plant products and against their spread within the Community

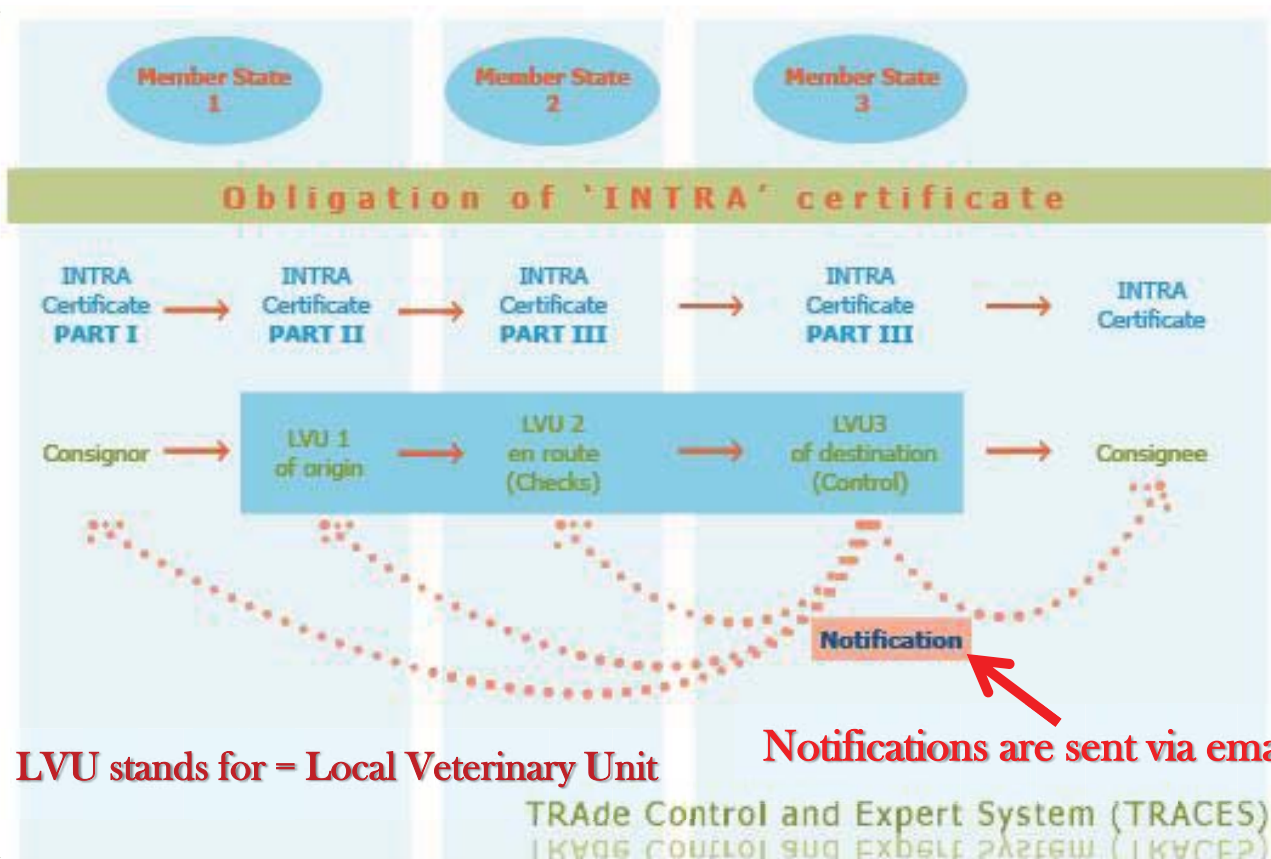

- **PART I (details of the consignment)**
Can be prepared by the economic operator OR the competent authority
- **PART II (Decision part)**
Processed by the competent authority (at the place of dispatch or at the BIPs)
- **PART III (Control part)**
Done by the competent authority at the place of destination
