manifest control

- to verify that all consignments subject to veterinary checks are submitted correctly
- to secure supervision of forwarders and customs
- requires full access to all airport and customs data

pre-announcement

- should be done with data of page 1 of CVED
- should be done with **TRACES**
- deadline one day in advance
- tools for enforcement are required (usually, if missing, there are additional fees)

Definitions Of Products Under Veterinary Control

➤ a clear and conclusive list of consignments to be checked

➤ **Combined Nomenclature:**

the vets „speak“ the language of customs

Composite Products

➤ composite product: a foodstuff intended for human consumption that contains both processed products of animal origin and products of plant origin and includes those where the processing of primary product is an integral part of the production of the final product

no veterinary check required for

- Biscuits ▪ Bread ▪ Cakes ▪ Chocolate ▪ Confectionery (incl. sweets)
- Unfilled gelatine capsules ▪ Olives stuffed with fish
- Food supplements packaged for final consumer (small amounts of animal product, including Glucosamine, Chondroitin, or Chitosan.
- Meat extracts and meat concentrates.
- Pasta and noodles not mixed or filled with meat product.
- Soup stocks and flavourings packaged for the final consumer, containing meat extracts, meat concentrates, animal fats, or
- Fish oils, powders or extracts.



frequency:

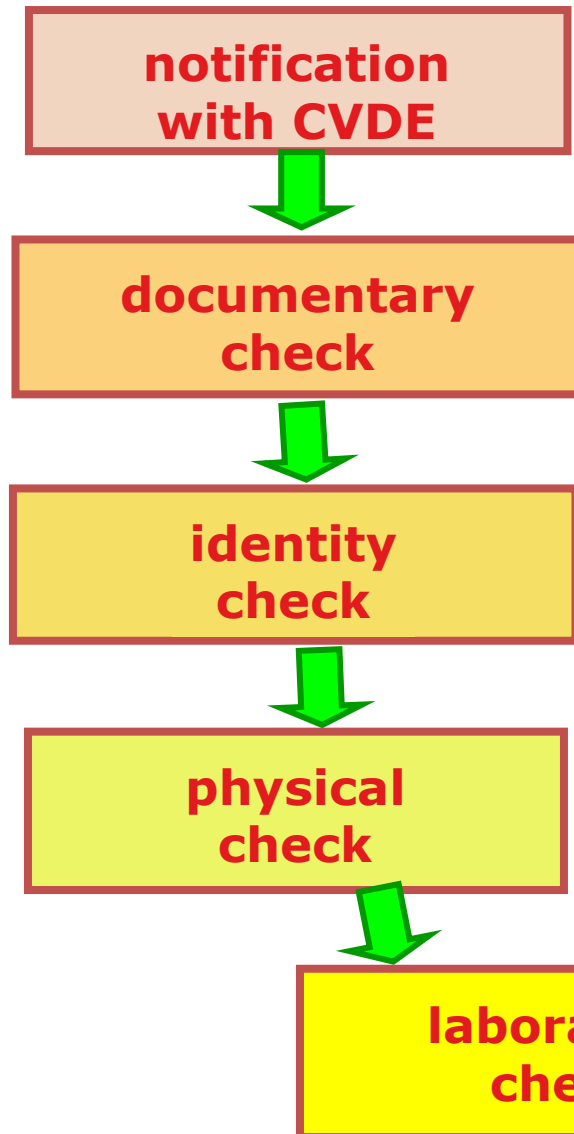
- 👁 ComDec 94/360 (20%, 50%)
- 👁 equivalency agreements (CAN, NZL)

procedure:

- partial unloading, as far as necessary
- 1%, min 2, max. 10; bulk: min. 5
- sensoric: smell, colour, consistence, taste etc.
- physical/chemical: cutting, thawing, cooking
- temp., pH
- re-sealing



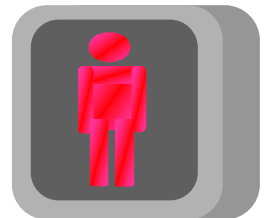
LABORATORY CHECK

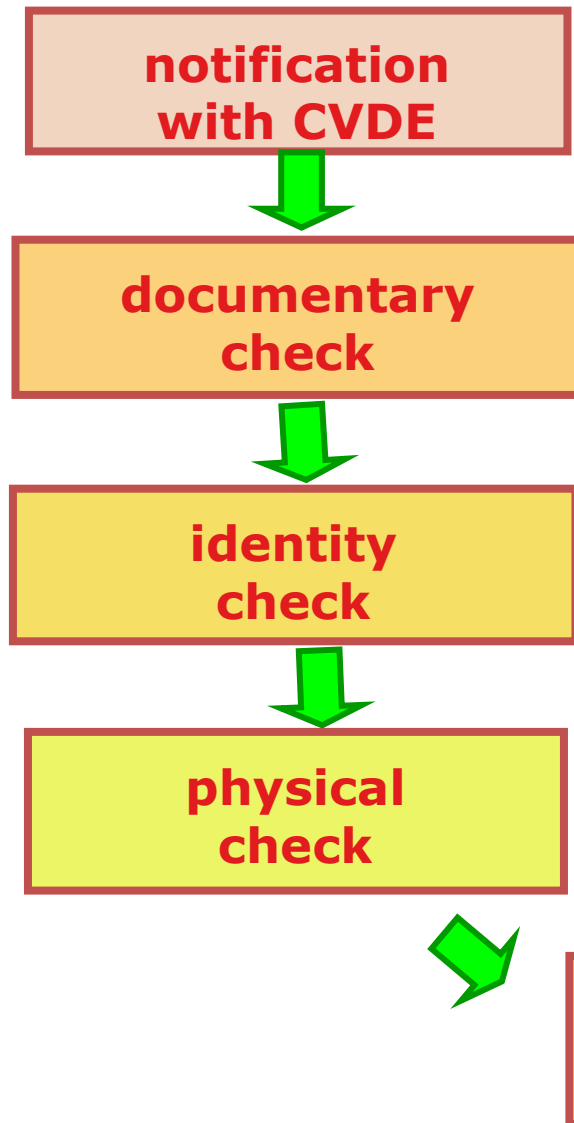


- 👁️ **random laboratory tests:**
 - 👉 residues, pathogens, contaminants
 - 👉 sampling plan –risk based
 - 👉 **consignment released**



- 👁️ **suspicion**
 - 👉 suspicion
 - 👉 previous tests positive (RASSF!)
 - 👉 **block consignments -> re-enforced check**

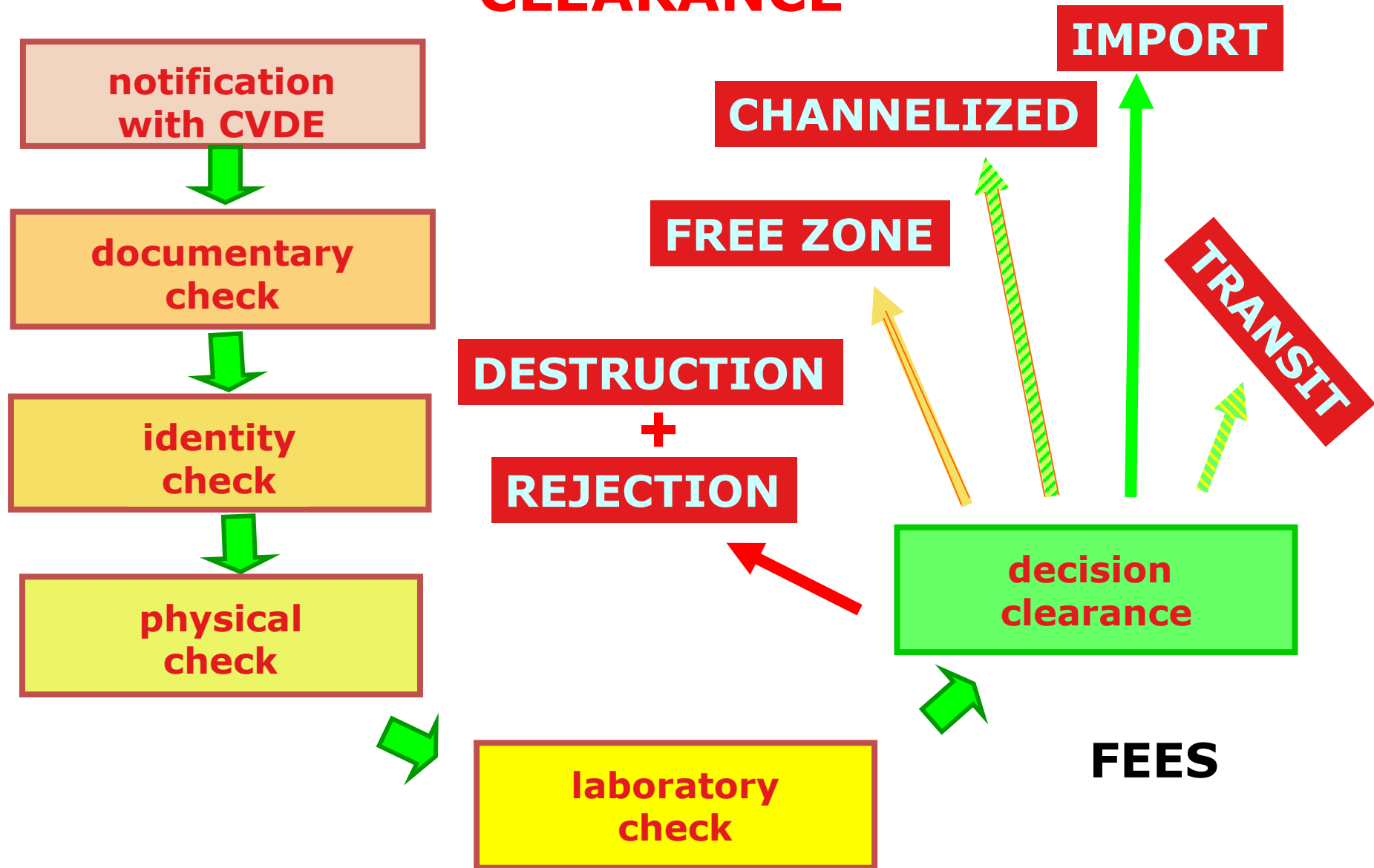
