Regulations on Labeling for Prepackaged Reduced Sodium Salt Products on the Market

- 1. The regulations are prescribed in accordance with Subparagraph 10_of Paragraph 1 of Article 22 of the Act Governing Food Safety and Sanitation.
- 2. Scope of application: Prepackaged food grade salt products that contain less than 65% of sodium chloride on the market.
- 3. The labeling required the following matters:
- (1) Prepackaged food grade salt products that have less than 65% of sodium chloride shall be named as "potassium salt" or "reduced sodium salt".
 - (2) The information shall be labeled on the <u>pre</u>packaged reduced sodium salt products: "Sodium-reduced" and the potassium content, and shall conspicuously labeled the warning statement in Chinese: "Nephropathy patient shall consult your physician or dietitian before use this product."
 - (3) The font of the warning shall not be less than four (4) millimeter –in length and width and its color shall be clearly distinguishable from -the background color of the product packaging.
