

**The names of all ingredients contained in the cosmetic product shall be indicated on the outer packaging**

*This Rule has been translated into English according to the original Chinese version. If there is any inconsistency or ambiguity between these two versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.*

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- 1 The names of all ingredients on the outer packaging of cosmetic product shall be indicated in Chinese or English with reference to the relevant official compendiums, such as International Cosmetic Ingredient Dictionary (INCI), Chinese Pharmacopoeia, US Pharmacopoeia, and European Pharmacopoeia or Chinese translations which DOH had approved to be added to the cosmetics product in the announcements.
- 2 The colorants shall be named in accordance with the nomenclatures for Color Index (CI) and EC Directive Annex IV by Food and Drug Administration (FDA). The ingredients list must include any fragrances in the product by including one of the following words: flavor(s), fragrance(s), parfum(s).
- 3 If the available marking area of the tester, giveaway, and packet product is less than 12 square inches, or it has the outer packaging which weight/volume is under or equal to 10gm/ml or not having the outer packaging which weight/volume is under 50gm/ml, the ingredient of product shall be indicated on the card, tag or package insert.
- 4 If the colorant has been added to or may be added to the series of makeup products for color matching, the name of common colorant shall be all listed first and then supplemented with the note "+/-" or with the term "may contain colorant".
- 5 The impurities in the ingredient, the secondary ingredient and flavor which were added during the production period but not existed in the product or the solvent which other ingredients required may not be indicated.
- 6 If the ingredient is commercial confidential and is not listed in Standards for Medicated Cosmetic, imported products shall be compliant with the regulations of the country of origin; domestic products shall be reported to the DOH, and then indicated as "other ingredients".
- 7 For cosmetic product which was manufactured, imported and launched to the market before the implementation of this announcement, it may be keep selling before expiry; however, the manufacturer shall have the data of all ingredients for consumers' reference. At the same time, the manufacture date shall be indicated on the products for identification.
- 8 That in violation of the provisions of this announcement has simultaneously violated the regulations of Article 6 of Statute for

Control of Cosmetic Hygiene and shall be punished in accordance with Article 28 of the said Statute.
