Sanitation standard for liquid eggs

1.MOHW Food No. 1081302824 Amended, 11/07/2019

Article 1

This Standard is prescribed in accordance with the provision of Article 17 of the Act Governing Food Safety and Sanitation.

Article 2

The types of shell eggs can be used for making liquid eggs:

- 1. The eggshell is intact without cracks.
- 2. The eggshell is cracked: The eggshell is damaged but the shell membrane is intact, without eggshell surface contamination and contents leakage.

Article 3

The eggs with broken shell are not permitted for making liquid eggs.

Article 4

Salmonella must not be detected in pasteurized liquid eggs.

Article 5

The total plate count must be below 10⁶ CFU/g in unpasteurized liquid eggs.

Article 6

This standard shall be implemented from 01, 01, 2020.
