- ii. the product described above has been obtained from animals which
- a) have been under routine checks/inspections implemented by the Cyprus' Veterinary Services.
- b) have resided in a country that has been free from Rinderpest for at least 12 months and where vaccination against Foot and Mouth Disease has not been carried out for at least 12 months.
- c) belong to holdings which have not been under any type of restrictions due to Foot and Mouth Disease or Rinderpest.

- d) have been subjected to regular Veterinary inspections in order to ensure that they comply with the animal health requirements laid down in Regulation (EC) No. 854/2004.
- iii. I am familiar with the animal health requirements foreseen by Regulation (EC) No. 854/2004.

3. Public Health Attestation

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify that: That the milk products made from heat-treated milk, described above,

- Have been manufactured from raw milk

 - e) obtained, collected, cooled, stored and transported in accordance with the relevant hygiene conditions laid down in Regulations (EC) No. 852, 853 and 854/2004,
 - f) complying with the total plate count and the somatic cell count standards laid down in Regulation (EC) No. 853/2004,
 - g) collected and where necessary, standardized, in accordance with the hygiene conditions laid down in Regulations (EC) No 852, 853 and 854/2004,
- ii. comes from an establishment and/or processing plant of equivalent level and guarantees to those laid down in Regulations (EC) No. 852, 853 and 854/2004 and which is subject to inspections and supervision by the

competent authority in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EC) No. 854/2004.

- iv. has undergone during manufacture process, the relevant heat treatment in accordance with the specific requirements of Regulation (EC)
 No. 853/2004, meets the relevant microbiological criteria laid down in Regulation (EC) No. 2073/2005,
- v. has been wrapped and packaged in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 852/2004,
- vi. was stored and transported in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EC) No. 852/2004,
- vii. was transported, where appropriate, in tanks as described in Regulation (EC) No. 852/2004,
- viii. was packaged in first and second packages, was marked with the exclusive identification mark (oval seal mark) of the approved establishment attributed by the competent authority
- ix. the radioactivity level of the products is in compliance with Regulation (EEC) No. 737/90.
