Recall details

Ottawa, April 11, 2017 - The food recall warning issued on April 4, 2017 has been updated to include additional product information. This additional information was identified during the Canadian Food Inspection Agency's (CFIA) food safety investigation.

Central Smith Creamery is recalling Wholesome Farms brand Sundae Cup products from the marketplace due to possible *Listeria monocytogenes* contamination. Consumers should not consume the recalled products described below. Food service institutions, such as hospitals and nursing homes, should not serve or use the recalled products described below.

What you should do

If you think you became sick from consuming a recalled product, call your doctor.

Check to see if you have recalled products in your home. Recalled products should be thrown out or returned to the store where they were purchased.

Food contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes* may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Symptoms can include vomiting, nausea, persistent fever, muscle aches, severe headache and neck stiffness. Pregnant women, the elderly and people with weakened immune systems are particularly at risk. Although infected pregnant women may experience only mild, flu-like symptoms, the infection can lead to premature delivery, infection of the newborn or even stillbirth. In severe cases of illness, people may die.

Background

The <u>CFIA</u> (Canadian Food Inspection Agency) is verifying that industry is removing recalled products from the marketplace.






