Ottawa, May 10, 2017 - The food recall warning issued on May 9, 2017 has been updated to include additional product information. This additional information was identified during the Canadian Food Inspection Agency's (CFIA) food safety investigation.

Industry is recalling certain ground meat products from the marketplace due to possible *E.* (*Escherichia*) *coli* O157:H7 contamination. Consumers should not consume the recalled products described below.
