



Updated Food Recall Warning - Lost Acre Variety brand of All Purpose Flour recalled due to *E. (Escherichia) coli* O121

Recall date: June 23, 2017

Reason for recall: Microbiological - E. coli O121

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Recall details

Ottawa, June 23, 2017 - The food recall warning issued on June 22, 2017 has been updated to include additional product information. This additional information was identified during the Canadian Food Inspection Agency's (CFIA) food safety investigation.

Lost Acre Variety is recalling Lost Acre Variety brand All Purpose Flour from the marketplace due to possible *E. (Escherichia) coli* O121 contamination. Consumers should not consume the recalled product described below.

What you should do

If you think you became sick from consuming a recalled product, call your doctor.

Check to see if you have recalled product in your home. Recalled product should be thrown out or returned to the store where it was purchased.

It is not safe to taste or eat raw dough or batter regardless of the type of flour used, as raw flour can be contaminated with harmful bacteria such as *E. (Escherichia) coli* O121. Food contaminated with *E. (Escherichia) coli* O121 may not look or smell spoiled but can still make you sick. Symptoms can include nausea, vomiting, mild to severe abdominal cramps and watery to bloody diarrhea. In severe cases of illness, some people may have seizures or strokes, need blood transfusions and kidney dialysis or live with permanent kidney damage. In severe cases of illness, people may die.

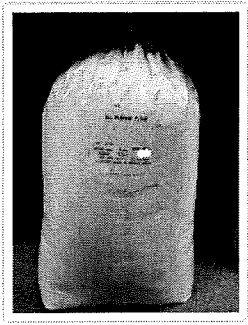
