

Control Instructions for Canadian Beef

Acceptance of imported Canadian beef inspection has resumed since July 8, 2016, and the imported beef shall meet the following requirements: (1) shall be healthy cattle having passed the ante-mortem inspection conducted by a veterinarian; (2) shall be cattle less than 30 months of age; (3) shall remove all “Specified Risk Materials (SRMs)” during slaughtering process; (4) shall be produced in factories that are eligible to export beef to Taiwan (5) every batch of the products shall be produced under the supervision of official veterinarians of the exporting country, ensuring the products conform to regulations regarding export to Taiwan; (6) each batch of the products shall be attached with sanitary certificate signed by CFIA veterinarians.
