Sanitation Standard for Disposable Chopsticks

- Article 1 This Standard is prescribed in accordance with the provisions of Article 17 of the Act Governing Food Sanitation.
- Article 2 The disposable chopsticks referred in this standard are those chopsticks made from bamboo or wood, intended for direct usage without washing or rinsing, and shall not be re-used.
- Article 3 No discoloration, off odor and flavor, contamination, mould, pest diseases, foreign matter or fibre fall off shall be found in disposable chopsticks.
- Article 4 The sulphur dioxide residue of the disposable chopsticks shall not exceed 500 ppm.
- Article 5 Hydrogen peroxide and diphenol shall not be detected in the disposable chopsticks.

Article 6 This Standard shall be implemented from December 1, 2007.

The amended articles hereof shall come into effect as of the day of promulgation.
